The keynote speaker for the 3rd annual symposium will be Dr. Scott L. Kastner, an associate professor of International Relations at the University of Maryland. Dr. Kastner is the author of the book, *Political conflict and economic interdependence across the Taiwan Strait and beyond*. He has published more than 10 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters all on the subject of policy and government. Dr. Kastner is a recipient of the National Defense University China Security Fellowship.

His seminar will explore the great deal of variation in how countries across the world are responding to a rising China. Some countries, for instance, have been much more willing than others to challenge China over its human rights record. Other countries challenge China more aggressively on economic issues. And a number of studies have pointed to variation in the extent to which countries in East Asia are willing to balance against growing Chinese power. This presentation explores the correlates of variation in national policies toward China. It focuses in particular on the extent to which individual countries have been willing to endorse PRC policies relating to Taiwan and Tibet.

A panel discussion will follow the keynote address. The panel will be composed of leaders in education, business and technology. The panel will continue a dialogue on the rise of China as it relates to the areas of culture, education, science, technology, business and trade. This event is free and open to the public.
