- Bring, Fax (823-8803), or e-mail your summer session class registration statement **by April 10, 2009, to avoid a break in monthly payments, as VA processing takes four weeks.** Active Duty Military and students enrolled for less than 6 credit hours must include tuition and fees statement.

Students will be notified by e-mail when the enrollment certification has been received for processing by the Department of Veterans.

Chapter 31 (Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Program)

- Obtain from your case manager the required Veterans Vocational Rehabilitation Authorization Form 28-1905 for enrollment, graduation fees and parking decal.
- Bring or fax (823-8803) your summer session class registration statement **by April 10, 2009 for early certification of enrollment to the VA.**

Students will be notified by e-mail when the Campus Bookstore authorization letter will be available for pick up from the NSU Veterans Affairs Office.
