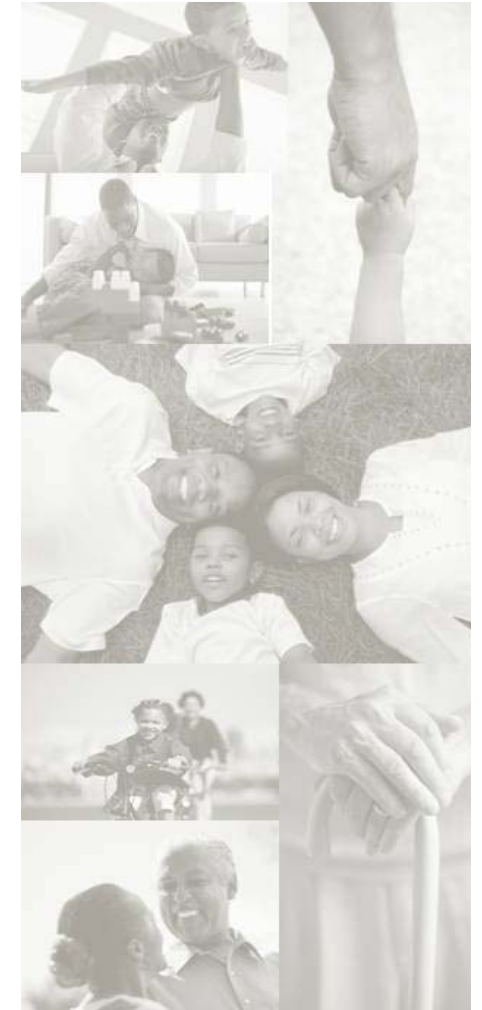

The Brambleton Community Outreach Center (BCOC) offers programs that seek to create a healthier community. Our mission is to provide professional, enriching services that will meet the needs of our members and the Brambleton Community.

Our History

The BCOC was the outgrowth of a federal government program. In its early days, the Center was a part of a series of satellite centers developed under Models City's Commission to deliver services to communities. The Center initially provided programs in recreation, public health, social service and probation services.

The City of Norfolk, having developed larger satellite centers in Huntersville, Berkley, Park Place and Ocean View decided to close the center in 1982. The building was officially turned over to NSU on September 19, 1983.

Norfolk State University's School of Social Work continues its tradition of service and community outreach functions with a base of operations at the Center.
