T-CUP is an innovative partnership between the Engineering programs at Norfolk State University and community college campuses. T-CUP outlines a curriculum that leads to the Master of Science in Engineering degree in just three years beyond the Associate of Science in Engineering degree. T-CUP also sponsors academic scholarships, peer mentors and tutors, community outreach activities, and bridge activities to support transfer students.

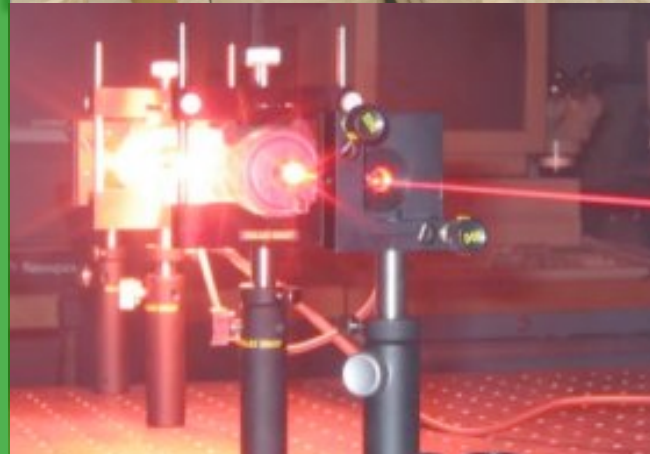
