

## HOW TO APPLY FOR A NATIONAL NROTC SCHOLARSHIP

- Complete the questionnaire found in the Navy/Marine ROTC college scholarships bulletin which is available through your local Navy Recruiter or by calling 1-800-USA-NAVY. Questionnaires should be received no earlier than March 1 and no later than January 1 of the year you are applying.
- Take the SAT or ACT test as early as possible and release scores directly to the NROTC program by using Code 0656 on the test registration form. (There is no other means of providing the scores.) The minimum SAT scores are 530 verbal and 520 math. The minimum ACT scores are 22 in English as well as 21 Math. Scores cannot be received before March and will not be considered if received after December 31.
- Apply to at least 3 of the universities you would like to attend. Acceptance to an NROTC approved college or university is your responsibility because the NROTC program cannot guarantee acceptance. It is advisable to apply to your university choices by November 1.
- Contact your local NROTC program coordinator to begin processing your application. Your coordinator will be identified in a letter indicating you are "board eligible" based on your questionnaire.
- Complete the application forms booklet with your local recruiting officer by the Jan 25 completion date so that it can be received at the main headquarters by the Jan 31 deadline.

- Consideration of your application by a selection board which will begin in September and continue meeting periodically through March.

## **HOW TO APPLY FOR A HBCU NROTC SCHOLARSHIP**

- The deadline for a HBCU NROTC scholarship is **15 AUG** of the freshman year. There are 16 HBCU's students can attend.
- Students must attend one of the 16 HBCU's that have an NROTC Unit.
- Students apply for a HBCU NROTC Unit through the NROTC Unit NROTC Recruiter.
- The requirements for a HBCU NROTC Scholarship are the same as a National NROTC Scholarship
