# SCHOOLS & COLLEGES

## SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

The School of Business at Norfolk State University is focused on preparing individuals for their chosen careers by creating a learner-centered community which promotes academic achievement and professional growth. The School of Business is working to make learning opportunities available to all who desire to grow professionally and advance their careers. Learner-centered communities exist on campus where students engage in face-to-face learning experiences with professors and other students. It also exists through online courses taken by students at their convenience in terms of time and location. The online programs are particularly attractive to the working professional.

The certificate programs are designed to allow participants to advance their careers according to their personal needs. The non-credit certificate programs offer Continuing Education Units (CEU's). CEU's are a widely recognized measure of participation in non-credit, professional education activities. The courses are designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills which offer them a competitive advantage for promotions in the corporate environment or success in entrepreneurial ventures. The School of Business offers online programs in Tourism and Hospitality Management, Project Management, and Supply Chain Management.

## SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

The School of Education is committed to ensuring an effectively prepared cadre of candidates who

will develop into highly qualified teachers. It fulfills its mission through its undergraduate and graduate programs in the fields of early childhood/elementary education, health and physical education, secondary education and school leadership and special education equipping candidates with the knowledge, skills, and dispositions to become successful teachers in a diverse society.

Online degree programs are designed for working professionals who want to complete quality advanced study. Online programs are offered in elementary education (*Master of Arts in Early Childhood Education and Pre-Elementary Education*), special education (*Master of Arts in Special Education Transition Specialist*) and secondary education (*Master of Arts in Educational Leadership-Administration and Supervision PK12*).

## COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS

The College of Liberal Arts at Norfolk State University is interested in educating the entire student in myriad ways. The College has nine academic departments plus Military Science. The College offers a broad range of academic disciplines in the Fine and Performing Arts (Fine Arts, Music), the Humanities (English and Foreign Languages, Mass Communications, and History) and the Social Sciences (Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Interdisciplinary Studies). While most of the students who major in one of the College's disciplines are undergraduates, the College also is the home of eight graduate programs.

The College of Liberal Arts has taken the lead in the field of Distance Learning at Norfolk State Uni-

versity. The University's only web-based degree, Interdisciplinary Studies, is housed inside the College. As of the Fall semester 2008, the College of Liberal Arts offers a total of forty-three courses online, with more being added each semester. Except for Fine Arts and Military Science, all departments have at least one course online, and four departments—English and Foreign Languages, History, Interdisciplinary Studies, and Psychology—offer six courses or more. The College of Liberal Arts is proud to say that it has more courses available for Distance Education than any other School or College at Norfolk State.

## COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY

The College of Science, Engineering, and Technology has over 1,800 students and presently comprises more than 25% of the University's enrollment. Students can select from a wide array of curricula in ten departments: Allied Health, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Naval ROTC, Nursing, Physics, and Technology. The College offers an environment that provides students with financial support, superior academic advising, interdisciplinary research mentoring, and exciting ways to learn science, engineering, and technology, including a substantial commitment to e-learning. Presently, 15 online courses are available to support instruction in biology, computer science, health services management, industrial management, and physical science. 28 courses are underdevelopment and will be offered beginning Fall 2009.

The College of Science, Engineering, and Tech-

nology has played a pivotal role in the University's history. Graduates secure outstanding jobs and are presently earning advanced degrees in record numbers. Faculty contributions in research, service, and mentoring are exceptional. The College currently houses several University research centers including the Center for Materials Research, the Center for Gaming and Simulation, the Center for Biotechnology and Biomedical Sciences, and the Institute for Information Assurance Research. The University has demonstrated a strong commitment to the sciences and health professions through a significant investment of university resources in accredited undergraduate educational programs, instructional and research facilities, and scholarships.

## SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK

The School of Social Work is committed to preparing professional social workers with the knowledge, values, skills and abilities to practice with diverse populations in a myriad of settings. This mission is fulfilled through the Baccalaureate (BSW), Masters (MSW), Ph.D. programs and Continuing Education activities. The BSW and MSW programs are fully accredited by CSWE.

The School offers courses online and is developing certificate programs in public health, gerontology, and military families for online delivery. Online academic offerings are designed for working professionals who desire to complete quality advance study, to excel in best practices and to be current and on the cutting edge in their specific competency areas.
