The course is centered on performing EKG's and interpreting EKG results through practical skills, demonstrations and hands-on learning. Laboratory assessments skills, which consist of non-invasive procedures, will be performed in a professional manner on classmates. Methods of treatments and Advanced Cardiac Life Support techniques are discussed. After completion of this class, students will be eligible to apply for EKG certification.

- Perform diagnostic tests
- Screen & follow up patient test results
- Assist w/examination, procedures and treatment
- Perform electrocardiography
- Set up patient for Holter Monitoring
- Interpret basic EKG's and recognize potentially lethal arrhythmias
