- Complete and return the **NSU Veterans Enrollment Reporting (VER) Form**, located on our Web site, [www.nsu.edu/veteransaffairs](http://www.nsu.edu/veteransaffairs).
- Bring, Fax (823-8803), or e-mail your fall semester class registration statement by **July 1, 2009**, **VA processing during peak periods takes four to six weeks**. Active duty military and students enrolled for less than 6 credit hours must provide a tuition and fees statement.
- Chapter 33 (new Post-9/11 GI Bill) program students must provide a copy of the **VA Certificate of Eligibility for benefits**.

Students will be notified by e-mail when the enrollment certification has been received for processing by the Department of Veterans Affairs.

**All advance payment requests must be submitted by June 22, 2009.**

### **Chapter 31 (Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Program)**

- Complete and return the **NSU Veterans Enrollment Reporting (VER) Form** located on our Web site, [www.nsu.edu/veteransaffairs](http://www.nsu.edu/veteransaffairs).
- Bring, Fax (823-8803), or e-mail your fall semester class registration statement by **July 1, 2009**, **as VA processing during peak periods takes four to six weeks**.
- Obtain from your case manager the required Veterans Vocational Rehabilitation Authorization Form 28-1905 for enrollment, graduation fees and parking decal.

Students will be notified by e-mail when the Campus Bookstore authorization letter will be available for pick up from the NSU Veterans Affairs Office.

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**Report any enrollment; any class changes; withdrawal from school, withdrawal and/or add/drop from courses to the Office of Veterans Affairs to prevent debt obligations to the Department of Veterans Affairs.**
