

Classification	Definition	Example Data types
Sensitive	Information that are restricted, with the highest Security\Privacy Requirements	Identifiers plus: * Major Identifiers (e.g. SSN, Passport, Driver's License, Health Insurance, MRN) * Payment Card holder data * Regulatory Data excluding FERPA (e.g. GLBA, HIPAA)
Confidential	Information that are confidential, with moderate security\privacy requirements	Identifiers plus: * Grades and GPA * Class schedule * Class Roster * Transcripts * Student Conduct record
Internal	FERPA/HB-1 directory information and other confidential business information	Examples include: * Internal business documents under NDA * Internal intellectual property * Some university financial data FERPA Directory Information may include: * Name * Date of birth * Photograph * Major field of study * Participation in officially recognized activities * Weight and height of athletic team members * Dates of attendance * Degrees, honors, and awards received * The most recent educational institution attended * Date Admitted * Degree sought * Compilation of Student Email Addresses
Public	Information that may have some minor sensitivity but are not regulated by laws and contracts; as well as public information	Examples include: * Enrollment numbers ready to be published * Business process documents * Public report
