## Virginia House Bill 1 Waiver

<u>Purpose</u>: To opt out of the VA HB 1 ruling so that NSU School of Education and/or personal contact information can be shared with the following:

- a. Schools and sites selected by you for field experiences conducted through the Office of Clinical Experiences and Student Services,
- b. Institutes that require teacher certification information that you are requesting for licensure verification.

Possible viewers of your contact information are the following: Human Resource Personnel, School or Agency Leadership, School Employees (i.e. counselor, administrative assistants, cooperating teachers, and/or assistant teachers).

<u>Background</u>: Virginia House Bill 1 which took effect July 1, 2018 as Code of Virginia Section 23.1-405©, prohibits a university from disclosing a student's email address, physical address or telephone number under the exception of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) for directory information or the Virginia Freedom Information Act (FOIA) unless the student has affirmatively consented in writing to the disclosure. This legislation covers students in all academic program levels: undergraduate, masters and doctoral.
