Application Requirements

Specifically, all attachments are to be uploaded as a .pdf file. Below are criteria and materials needed to ensure that your application provides a clear and compelling display of you as a candidate into the Teacher Education Program.

Requirements

- **2.75** Cumulative GPA or higher
- Minimum completion of **30** university credit hours
- Pass EDU 201 (grade of C or higher)
- A copy of official passing score on the **Virginia Communication and Literacy Assessment (VCLA)**
- Academic Program Evaluation (from My NSU Self Service menu)
- **Evaluation of Dispositions form** from a NSU professor (ideally from a course with fieldwork). Email the form link to your selected evaluator and include your full legal name, NSU Student ID number, Academic Department, Academic Program, and NSU email address.
- Type the evaluator's title (e.g. Dr., Ms., Mr., Mrs.), first and last name and email address of the identified faculty member.

- Reading Score 235 or higher
- Writing Score 235 or higher
- Composite Score 470 or higher

- Explanation of how deficiencies were corrected
- Provide documentation demonstrating that you have corrected the deficiencies (i.e. passing VCLA score, 2.75 GPA, etc.)
