Recipients must maintain a full-time status with a minimum course load of **12 credit hours per semester** and be in good academic standing with a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Applicants must also file the current 2022-2023 FASFA with the Department of Education.

<u>Priority Deadlines</u>: Fall -August 22, 2022- Spring- December 1, 2022- Please complete and submit to the Office of Transfer Admissions & Services by 5 p.m. <u>Applicant must be registered</u> for 12 or more credit hours at the time of application. Please submit a copy of your registration statement/schedule with your application. Only complete application packets will be reviewed.
