



Policy for Testing Using ProctorU Remote Monitoring Service

Important Testing Information

During the remote testing of the HESI A2, you are being recorded, and your video will be reviewed by an assigned Proctor and, when applicable, the Nursing Department Director.

The exam is designed to assess the academic and personal readiness of prospective students. Therefore, the NSU policy on Academic Integrity will be applicable to this test as with other academic course work.

Tips for testing

- i. Identify a quiet location where you will not be interrupted during testing.
 1. Suggestions:
 - a. Reserve a student room in the library
 - b. Contact the student success center to reserve a study room
 - ii. The night before testing, charge your computer
 - iii. The day before testing, ensure equipment function, if needed, contact technical support prior to testing
 - iv. All watches are to be removed and cell phones should be in the off position.
 - v. Ensure the room contains lighting which allows face to be visible in the camera

Taking HESI A2 via ProctorU, the Students are to:

- Perform an Environmental Scan:
 - During testing, the student should be alone in their designated space (this includes the room should be without pets)
 - Identification- Use Government Identification only
 - Scan the desk, include a 360 perimeter scan (Includes scanning to the left and right of your testing area) immediate environment
 - Place 2 blank sheets of scrape paper on the desk and one pencil
- Ensure equipment functionality:
 - Turn on the microphone and maintain the microphone in the on position throughout the exam.
 - Check that your face is visible in the center of the screen, and it must remain in this position throughout the test.

Non-compliance with the stated Testing instructions:

- Consequences for violating the testing protocol may invalidate the exam results.
