The Committee voted and unanimously approved with a 3-0 Roll Call Vote, the Minutes for March 5, 2026, Committee Meeting, motioned by Dr. L.D. Britt, and seconded by Mr. Hall.

Mr. Blake provided the General Assembly update, highlighting that the 2026 Legislative Session has concluded. Mr. Blake also informed that a series of bills have been submitted to the Governor for consideration, with a deadline of May 22nd for approval or veto.

6. Board of Visitors Update(s)

7. General Assembly Update(s)

Mr. Claville discussed two bills that are currently before the Governor that were passed by the General Assembly and may impact the University and the Board of Visitors. The bills are summarized below:

Collective Bargaining Bill: Addresses the composition of employees within the service workforce.

SB494: Addresses the composition, membership, and duties of Boards of Visitors for public institutions of higher education. The bill increases Board Member terms from four to six years and requires each institution to adopt policies defining and implementing shared governance as part of its institutional structure.

8. Policy Update(s)

Dr. White provided an update on the status of the University's policies, informing them that everyone has been working diligently on their development and review. She outlined the following steps in the policy review process:

- Review by the respective division
- Legal sufficiency review
- Review by the President and the Executive Cabinet
- Presentation to the campus community for public comments and questions

Dr. White highlighted that the Board Policies are approximately 85% to 90% complete, while Administrative Policies are about 75% complete. She indicated that there is a targeted completion date of June 30, 2026.

Mr. Blake noted that four Board documents required reaffirmation and readoption. These include:

- Code of Ethics
- Statement of Governance
- Qualifications and Competencies for Governing Board Membership
- Norfolk State University Bylaws

Mr. Conrad Hall motioned to recommend to the Full Board reaffirmation and readoption of the policies, seconded by Dr. Britt, and with a 3-0 Roll Call vote the Board unanimously approved.
