THE TIMELESS IMPACT OF GIVING TO Norfolk State University

The Norfolk State University **Report on Philanthropy** is produced annually to share highlights and achievements of University Advancement's fundraising programs, and to tell the stories of as well as to thank the University's benefactors. Despite the waning impacts of COVID-19, Spartans kept moving forward with determination and purpose. And University financial supporters were steadfast.

Your continued and selfless giving to NSU, our students, services, and programs has a recurring impact that resonates throughout the institution. Over the decades, your financial support has enabled the University to expand academic programs, offer financial aid to more students, hire more faculty and program administrators, and enabled Norfolk State to carry out its mission around the globe.

Norfolk State University showed up and showed out in 2022. The 87-year-old institution, nestled near the shores of the Elizabeth River, continued to make important

developments in research, academics, performing arts, athletics, new business partnerships, community engagement, and so much more – all thanks to the generosity of our donors, sponsors and friends. University Advancement and the Office of Development have cultivated a legion of supporters by creating solid cases for giving, and by connecting donors to areas of the University they are passionate about.

YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS IN ACTION – JUST THE HIGHLIGHTS:

- Landing again on the international stage, the mighty **Spartan Legion Marching Band** performed in the 134th Annual Rose Bowl Parade in Pasadena, California. In a 2021 interview with the executive director of Alumni Relations and Annual Giving, it was estimated that it would take approximately a million dollars for the trip. Your contributions helped us to reach the mark.

- During the observance of NSU's 87th anniversary, our donors and supporters gave generously during the university's Day of Giving event held in September. Even within a short timespan to give, Spartans accepted the challenge, and the fundraising goal was exceeded by raising \$40,000.
- Donors made significant contributions in 2022, including several alumni who reached the \$100,000 mark in cumulative giving; a \$25,000 gift designated to the University's area of greatest need, and another gift of \$1 million to fund an endowed faculty position.
- Norfolk State University's business partnerships with Pharrell Williams, companies like IBM, Apple Inc., and Microsoft have established the University as a strong business collaborator and innovator drawing the attention of additional corporate donors like Dollar Tree Inc.
- The Landmark Foundation, funding a host of projects around the region, has now committed to the future of Norfolk State students with a \$5 million gift to create a scholarship fund for Spartans who need financial assistance. This is the second largest gift in the University's history.

- Faculty, staff, and administrators have historically supported NSU students by giving all through the year and for a variety of different causes. For 2022, the Administrators, Faculty/Staff campaign shone as a beacon of their belief in the University, its leadership, mission, and its students.

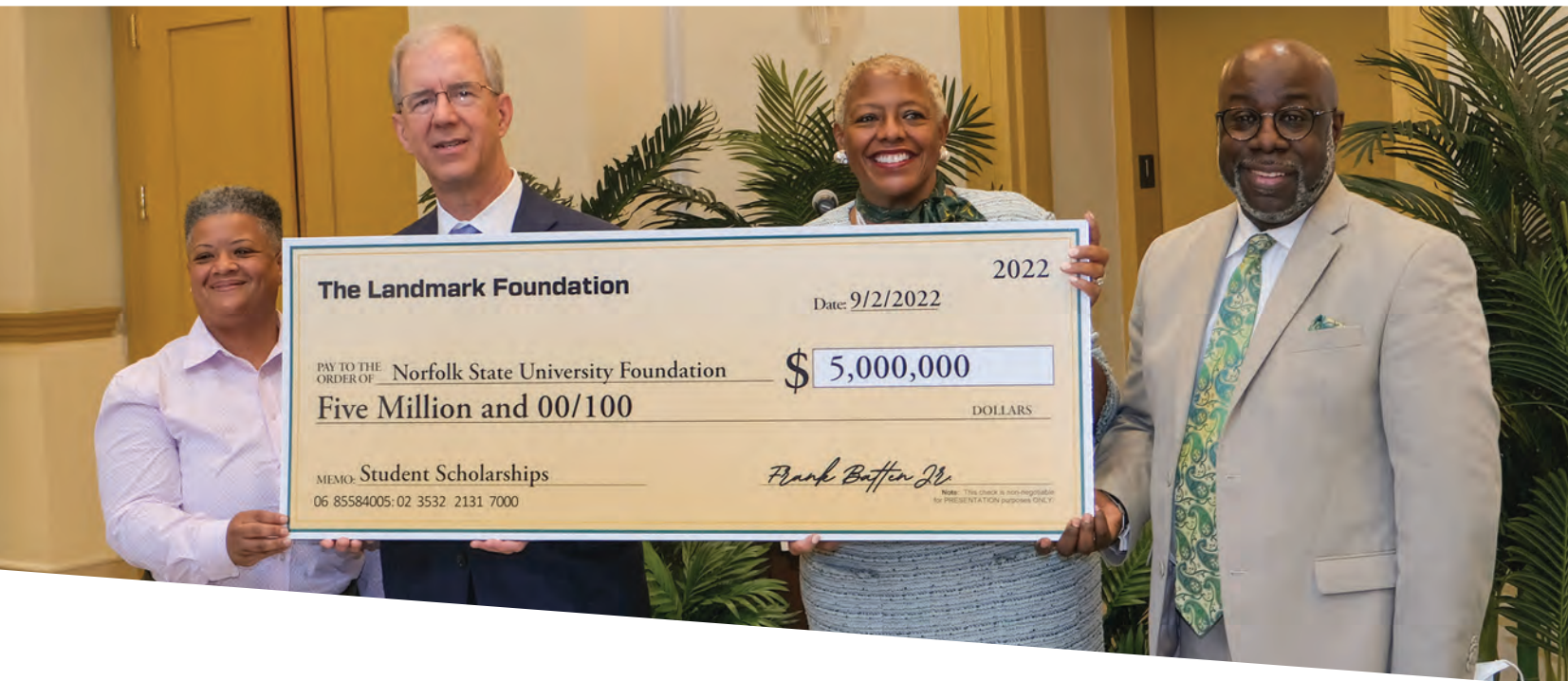

THE LANDMARK FOUNDATION

Provides 2nd Largest Gift In University's History



Say Landmark Communications to anyone in Hampton Roads and the first images that come to mind are The **Virginian-Pilot** daily newspaper and its iconic and historic building at 150 W. Brambleton Avenue. But as the old song goes, “everything must change,” and so it has with Landmark and **The Virginian-Pilot**. Landmark Communications, now Landmark Media Enterprises, endowed funding that created The Landmark Foundation. “For a while it was a company foundation,” said Landmark Foundation president Frank Batten. Although still employed by Landmark Media Enterprises, Batten spends the bulk of his time working for the foundation and serving on various charitable boards.

The Landmark Foundation awarded Norfolk State University \$5 million in 2022. “It was not our first gift to the University . . . though it was our largest. In previous

years, we had given more modest annual gifts to the University’s Presidential Scholars program. The award will provide support for scholarships to students hailing from the Commonwealth of Virginia. By our giving, it hopefully will encourage others to give to this campaign. We gave to Norfolk State because it has a lot of students that have the potential to change the world, but also have a lot of financial need. It’s heartbreaking to hear about somebody that has to drop out of college because they can’t afford the tuition.”

Thinking back on the selection process, Batten told *The Report on Philanthropy*, “We wanted to support Norfolk State because it’s an especially important institution in Hampton Roads and in Virginia. Norfolk State not only provides an education for students seeking undergraduate degrees, but it has wonderful graduate programs. It is a leading university for feeding African American graduates

into Ph.D. programs in the sciences. NSU is important to making Hampton Roads successful and, in order for that to happen, the institution has to be successful."

Batten takes a more practical approach to what the contribution will really do . . . "We hope that it will keep a number of students in school and make a difference between graduating and dropping out. We hope that it will be a big impact on hundreds of students." When asked what he would say to others considering giving to Norfolk State, Batten stated, "Norfolk State is a wonderful institution. It is a well-led university under Javaune Adams-Gaston (Dr. J.) who is a fantastic president. You want to give to an institution that is well-run, with students who have great potential."

The Landmark Foundation concentrates its resources in several areas. "Our focus is on southeastern Virginia in the areas of education, human services, and environmental issues." When requests or opportunities come in, the foundation's directors decide what projects to fund. "There are four directors and I serve as the administrator."

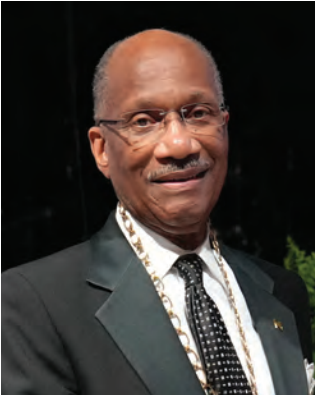
True to its mission, The Landmark Foundation has funded the following campaigns through its charitable giving:

In providing further reflection on NSU's donation, Batten expressed the foundation's strategy for choosing the area of need-based scholarships. "We wanted to focus on in-state students because they pay lower tuition. These scholarships will help students with the greatest need."

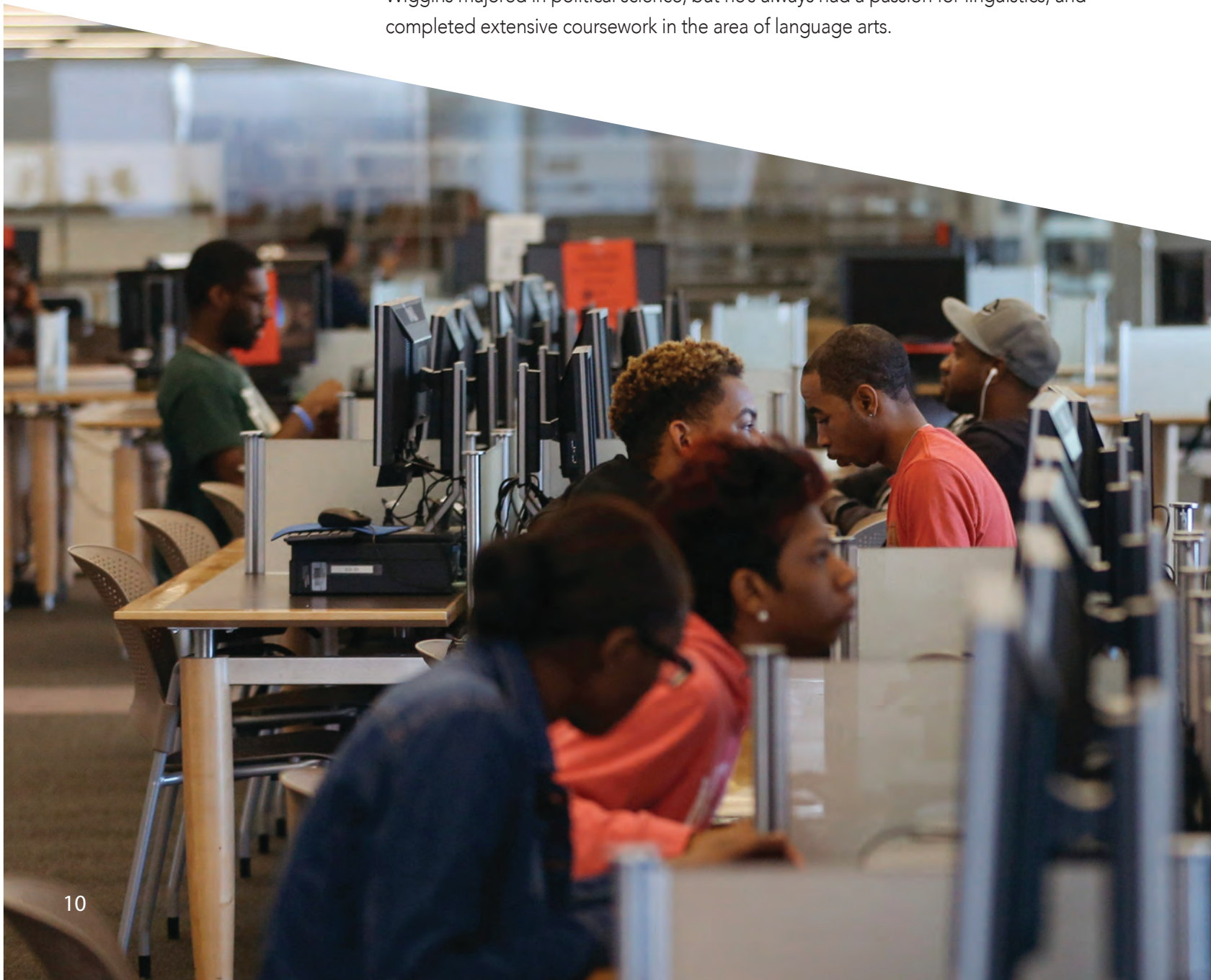

Reaches Milestone

Joseph Wiggins ('66) is the kind of man who does not back down from a challenge and when he makes a promise you can take it to the bank. After receiving his first solicitation to donate to Norfolk State, via a telephone call from a student who encouraged him to make a pledge, Wiggins recounted, "I agreed to the amount the student suggested. When the list was published, I was totally embarrassed. I made a solemn pledge to myself that I would share my blessings with the institution that provided the foundation that enabled me to succeed and become a valued member of the community, and the local educational system I was privileged to serve. I became a committed annual giver in 2002."

Wiggins majored in political science, but he's always had a passion for linguistics, and completed extensive coursework in the area of language arts.



Today, the retired 51-year career veteran educator and school administrator, has reached the \$100,000 milestone and earned his place in the Lyman Beecher Brooks Society. "I am deeply indebted to my alma mater. I cannot forget the invaluable role that NSU has played in my life. For that reason, I have a sincere desire to give back to the institution that enabled me to become a successful school leader and a success in each of my endeavors."

Wiggins says that he continues to give to the University because he could never repay the individuals who assisted him in obtaining a high-quality education. He reflects on the legacy of University leaders and administrators and the one-on-one care he received as a student. "Dr. William P. Robinson Sr., my college advisor, treated me with the utmost respect. He left a positive, indelible impression on me as well as many of his other students." He remembered the intervention of Dr. Lyman B. Brooks' secretary, Mrs. Fannie Taylor. Her caring attitude and attention to detail enabled Wiggins to get his state scholarship processed

in a timely fashion. He intends to give back in meaningful ways to help other worthy students enrolled at Norfolk State. "I designated my contributions for academic scholarships for deserving students. I attended NSU on an academic scholarship, graduated with distinction and I want to carry it forward," Wiggins declared.

When asked about the opportunity to speak to potential donors and what'd he say, Wiggins told the Report on Philanthropy that he was a little dismayed at the number of former NSU students who do not give to the University. "I am baffled by it. Many former students have been highly successful in their chosen fields of study. Perhaps we need to stress the prime importance of lending a helping hand to many who really need the vital help that a scholarship provides. We cannot repay those who helped us, but we can exert an effort to assist other deserving college students who enroll at NSU."

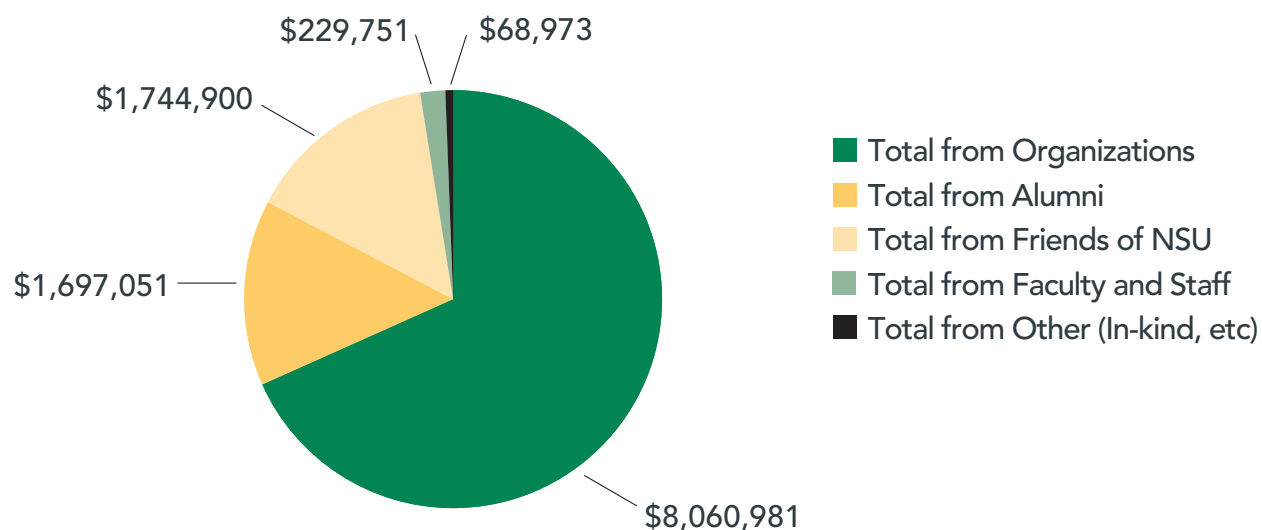

DONOR'S GIFT CREATES

Endowed Professorship

With the debate about teaching American history making headlines around the country, a Norfolk State University benefactor has gifted the University a million dollars to endow a professorship in constitutional and US history. Conrad Mercer Hall, a native of Norfolk, is a longtime civic activist, an ardent ocean sailboat racer, a map collector, and a historical researcher among his other pursuits. In 2020, he published his first book titled, *A Select History of Mathews County Virginia – 17th, 18th and 19th Centuries*.

Hall has been involved in various civic activities for years including previously serving as chairman of the CHKD Foundation, two terms on the Board of Visitors at Old Dominion University, and recently completed an eight-year stint on the ODU investment committee. In addition, he has served as a trustee of the VMI Foundation Inc., a trustee for the ACCESS College Foundation, and he is a trustee of the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation. He served as an artillery officer in the United States Army and eventually earned an MBA from the University of Virginia. His bio tells the story of



a life of service and engagement – changing organizations and people along the way.

Regarding his gift to Norfolk State, Hall explained, “The creation of a chair in American and Constitutional History was made in an effort to correct a great deficiency, most notably a significant reduction, and in some cases a complete absence in teaching of history, and how our form of government works. There is a large segment of the population who cannot name the three branches of government, who can’t name the vice president, who has never heard of the Federal Reserve or the Supreme Court – and on it goes.” Hall feels that this lack of understanding among citizens is a great threat to the survival of the country – a far greater threat than China, Russia, and other risks.

He believes that we the people have grown lax in our efforts toward impactful civic engagement. In a speech at Norfolk Academy in 2014, titled *Civic Engagement and the Common Good*, Hall wrote, “Keep this in mind: citizenship is a practice, not a status. So how are we doing as citizens as measured by civic engagement? Unfortunately, not well at all. The fundamental level of civic engagement is to know one’s neighbors and to vote. We are destroying ourselves from within. And most regrettably, this condition is associated with a dramatic withdrawal from civic engagement which is the glue of our society.”

With Hall’s generous support, his aspiration is that Norfolk State University will effect change. “It is the expectation that an understanding of American and Constitutional history will work towards the strong desire of all involved with NSU, to equip students with the absolute best education that will enable them to be leading citizens. Our graduates will be distinguished, differentiated, and equipped to be highly sought after in their chosen fields of employment and in public service.” His goal is that graduates will know and be able to explain and teach others about the uniqueness of our form of government, and its benefits – something that far too many take for



granted. Hall also hopes that in the future, the course will be required for all NSU students and be a prerequisite for receiving a diploma.

When asked why support a history chairmanship at this time, Hall told the *Report on Philanthropy*, “I wish it could have been done years ago. There is no time to waste in this matter. I made this gift individually and not through a foundation. It was given to NSU out of my admiration for Dr. J. (Javaune Adams-Gaston), her faculty, staff, and the enthusiasm and dedication to academic excellence exhibited by the students.”

In encouraging others to give to Norfolk State University, the civic activist and Norfolk native said, “As for potential donors to the University, the case to be made is extensive, and can be tailored to the interests of each prospect. An over arching point to be made in fundraising is the fact that NSU significantly overachieves given its limited financial resources. This puts the University in the realm of being a vital and significant asset to the state and the nation.”

Norfolk State University Foundation President BELIEVES IN FINANCIAL LITERACY



Norfolk State University has an enduring history in the Hampton Roads community and beyond. And no one can better attest to that fact than Travis Ames, Norfolk State University Foundation (NSUF) President. "I am a native of Hampton Roads

and reared between Norfolk and Portsmouth," said Ames reflecting on his childhood and deeply embedded connection to the University. "My passion for this work comes from wanting to give back to a rich legacy that gave me so much."

Travis Ames understands money, how it works, and how to leverage it so that it can work for an individual or an institution. "There is a great need for our community to understand the value of a financial education. We can do more with our resources, but fear is our number one enemy." He says that many people are afraid to give because they believe they will not have enough for their own needs. "On the contrary, everyone who embraces a life of giving knows that you end up with more money, joy, friends and extended family through the gift of sharing."

Having held several positions on the foundation board including serving on the finance committee and as treasurer, Ames assumed the leadership role in 2020. "My primary responsibility is stewardship governance. I help the foundation to leverage their talents and skills to manage, support and administer assets on behalf of students and programs that we support on a university level." Additionally, he works with staff, board members and University constituents to raise awareness and dollars.

"I also work closely with the University administration and the Board of Visitors with the goal of extending Norfolk State's reach into the future."

Ames equates the NSUF to a family. "Our seasoned board members, who hold the knowledge and wisdom, freely share their experiences. Because of this, I have absorbed as much knowledge and wisdom as possible to govern prudently. It's the love for the University and its impact on me that has, I think, compelled me to grow here." In discussing the role of the foundation, Ames stated, "The primary duties of the Norfolk State University Foundation are to govern, manage and allocate the funds received from donors and other philanthropic organizations for the benefit of providing scholarships and supporting programs for students."

The NSU Foundation president is a devout believer in the power of money and sound fiscal management. "Every philanthropic organization seeks to exist in perpetuity. Endowed dollars are the economic engine that allows money to flow at all times for the support of students. The larger the engine, the more production we get." In his analogy, Ames equates the endowment growth engine to that of a car engine. "There is greater production from a V8 engine versus a V4 engine. The larger the endowment, the easier it is to weather financial crisis and have less demand on limited dollars to meet financial obligations. This allows for real dollars to reach students, create, and identify new ways to support them in their growth, because additional resources are available due to having a surplus. We can reach more students and increase our programs such as athletics, the arts and sciences and compete on a larger scale – all because the engine is larger. It's these demands that call upon the endowment for support."

Norfolk State University's current endowment is roughly \$82 million according to Ames. The strategy for its steady growth . . . "One of the greatest ways to ensure the endowment's steady growth is by having a strong financial committee. Its role is to make sure we are keeping to the investment policy set forth to govern endowed dollars." The foundation's finance committee is also responsible for "acquiring experts to facilitate with market trends that fit our strategy and keep us on track from a risk reward perspective."

Ames' personal beliefs about philanthropy align with his upbringing, education, and training. He says that we all are the benefactors of philanthropy. "Philanthropy is a divine principle – it's others first – always. The giving of oneself is the first step. People who are givers seek

to change the lives of others." To encourage others to support Norfolk State, Ames would tell them about his family legacy and its connection to the University. He would reflect on his thoughts about once overlooking the campus from the president's office and thinking . . . *I'm supposed to be doing something here, something great.*

Legacy of Giving

IS A FAMILY AFFAIR



Ever thought about your legacy? The dictionary defines legacy in simple terms of family money and/or property left in a will. One definition expands the list to include reputation. A legacy should be one's ability to impact another's life and to empower someone else to become better. Sisters Crystal, DeShera and Glenda Lassiter know and live the meaning of legacy.

Longtime benefactors to the University, the Lassiter sisters come from a family that set the bar, a standard, and created a family legacy of giving to Norfolk State University. Crystal, an electrical and electronics engineering major, attended NSU from 1988 to 1992. "As a child of parents, aunts, and uncles – all alumni of the University, I had a connection to NSU even before attending. After graduating and maturing, I have a greater awareness of my obligation to give back as an alumna," she said. Glenda attended NSU from 1982 to 1986. She majored in journalism and currently works as a senior systems engineer, freelance writer, and editor.

Glenda mirrored her sister's sentiments about the connection to NSU. "My Spartan connection began long before I was college age, even before high school. My parents are proud Norfolk State alums, as are several of her siblings. My mother was very active in the alumni association, locally and at the national level. Norfolk State was the source of many personal experiences in my youth, and that of my sisters, such as swimming lessons, attending theatre performances, and the intriguing chance to hear Maya Angelou read her poetry."

Glenda has been a "serious" donor to NSU since 2014, "at my Uncle Curtis Hurdle's urging, we established a scholarship in my mother's memory." Crystal first gave to NSU in 1993. "My first contribution was minimal – maybe \$50," Crystal reflected. "I donated because as I looked at PWIs (predominately White institutions), I saw the benefits on their campuses and sports teams afforded by alumni contributions. As a graduate of an HBCU, I often ask – 'if we don't support our schools, who will?' My mother definitely set the example for me and my sisters, who are also NSU graduates, to give back to the University." Each of the sisters agree that giving back is their responsibility.

The Lassiters understand the meaning of legacy and are set on a path that will greatly impact NSU and its students. Crystal talks about becoming a legacy giver. "I became a legacy giver because I was financially able to do so. I would one day like to have a building on campus named after my mother. That is today's goal. It's my obligation to give back to the University that contributed to the ability to have the career I have," confirmed Crystal. Glenda added, "Such philanthropy is an action toward the global recognition trajectory of NSU and its students."

Crystal Lassiter designates her contributions to an endowed scholarship fund. "After my mother's unfortunate death, my family established an endowment in her name. The Shirley Hurdle Lassiter Memorial Scholarship Fund provides financial support to English majors." Glenda designates her



donations to the same memorial fund created to honor their mother, but she also supports the Kathy and Jeffrey Belfield Endowed Scholarship, the Spartan Legion and Delta Sigma Theta Epsilon Theta Chapter. Given the opportunity to talk to future or prospective donors, Crystal would tell them, "It is our responsibility to give back to assist those who are trying to obtain an education." Glenda would take a practical approach in speaking with prospective donors. "A small commitment can be bigger than you think. Consider this: If every person who graduated from Norfolk State gave something each year, together we could further broaden research, marketing, and even internship opportunities. If you have never been a donor, perhaps rethink that and give small versus never at all."

As a legacy giver at Norfolk State University know that we recognize your passion and commitment to impact the lives of students so their journey in life will be better.

Staff's Fundraising Strategy Is Right on the Money

Despite a rapidly changing discipline, a global pandemic, and a fluctuating economy, Norfolk State University fundraisers in the University Advancement Division, are prepared to meet these challenges and more.

UNIVERSITY ADVANCEMENT STAFF Q&A

Michelle Norfleet works in *Development Services and Stewardship* serving as the Database Coordinator. The Report on Philanthropy caught up with Norfleet after yet another busy week.

Q: How long have you been with Norfolk State University's Development Services and Stewardship?

A: I often hesitate when I get this question and sometimes I can't believe I've been working at NSU for almost 22 years and 20 years have been with the Development Services and Stewardship team in various roles.

Q: How do you feel your role contributes to the success of the development services department?

A: I think my role contributes to the success of the department the same way a production crew works behind the scenes or curtains to put on a show. There are so many finite details involved from cultivating relationships to securing gifts.

I feel like my role is critical to the success of development services because without good data we aren't able to provide accurate information to our constituents, store and protect the integrity of all the information we receive, retrieve the information as needed and be able to tell the story. The more data we record, the more complete picture we have to tell the constituents' stories and our own.

I also feel like my role makes it easier to connect with people which affects not only development services, but also University Advancement and NSU.

Q: Donor confidentiality and record privacy are vital in University Advancement. How does NSU ensure a high level of donor ethics?

A: NSU ensures a high level of donor ethics by following the Donor Bill of Rights and CASE (Council for Advancement and Support of Education) reporting and management standards.

We also have policies and procedures in place to safeguard our donor information to maintain donor confidentiality and record privacy.

Q: In your experience with donor services and stewardship, what do you like the most?

A: I truly enjoy the relationship building that I am able to do and facilitate as a part of the development services and stewardship team. The relationships with donors, colleagues and students are all rewarding in their own ways. I think the division epitomizes the “Culture of Care” that NSU continues to demonstrate.



SHANA JAMES

Assistant Vice President For Development

Shana James serves as the Assistant Vice President for Development. She has a no-nonsense approach to fundraising that connects to donors, prospects and friends interested in Norfolk State University.

Q: What is your role in the University Advancement Division?

A: As the AVP for Development, I lead a team of professionals who help facilitate all major gifts to the University. My team and I work with donors who wish to make an impactful gift of \$25,000 or more to the institution. We help our donors become change-makers. Each investment provides an opportunity for NSU to recruit and retain the best and the brightest future leaders. More importantly, we help donors realize their goals of leaving a mark and for some, a legacy through strategic giving avenues such as real estate, gifts by will, stocks and other appreciated assets, IRA distributions and cash, of course!

Q: How long have you been with Norfolk State?

A: I joined NSU in 2020 and prior to my career at Norfolk State I worked with several non-profits such as The Salvation Army and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. I've worked as a fundraiser for over 23 years.

Q: How do you connect with donors to encourage them to support NSU?

A: Each donor is unique. There is no cookie-cutter approach to this level of interaction with our donors. It is always important to me that donors are educated on the different ways to give. Giving by way of check or credit card is most common, however, I like to remind donors over the age of 70.5 that giving from their IRA is a great alternative. I also like to remind donors that giving stock today, purchased for a significantly lower price 20 years ago is an alternative option to giving cash.

Q: In your fundraising experience, what do you like the most?

A: I really have enjoyed getting to know so many different people at different stages in life all with generous hearts offering gifts. I genuinely enjoy learning why people are inspired to give. I have formed lifelong relationships with donors over the past 20+ years. Relationships have blessed my soul. But the icing on the cake is when I get to see the results of a donor's benevolence. For example, when I learn of a student who is short \$600 and we have a fund from a donor that can help that student complete another semester. Or when a student who came from a home where saving for college wasn't viable, and knowing we have funds that can assist with that. Those stories are what I love about this career journey.

TRAVEL TO PASADENA FOR THE ROSE PARADE



NSU alumnus and former high stepper with the Legion's Hot Ice, Tarvaris Taylor, made the trip to Pasadena, California to watch her beloved Spartan Legion Marching Band in the iconic New Year's Day Rose Parade.

Her trip was quite the odyssey and offers another demonstration of alumni commitment to Norfolk State University.

Taylor is a 1998 NSU graduate who majored in Interdisciplinary Studies. She continued her education receiving a master's in Urban Education Guidance and Counseling in 2001. She is a life member of the Norfolk State University Alumni Association (NSUAA) and vice president of the Alumni Band Chapter. "In October 2021, I was getting ready to watch the Legion's homecoming

halftime performance when the announcement was made (the Spartan Legion Marching Band selected to perform in the 134th Annual Rose Parade). I was so excited to know the band would be representing HBCUs in the world-renowned Rose Bowl Parade." She decided at that moment she was not going to miss the opportunity to travel to Pasadena to see the Spartan Legion perform.

Preparing to depart December 29, 2022, she and her family were caught up in the Southwest Airlines national flight cancellation debacle. "I was notified by the airline on the 27th that my flight was canceled." During the busiest travel time of the year, Christmas week, Southwest Airlines canceled 70 percent of its scheduled flights. Winter storms, fog, staffing shortages, and internal technology failures hindered crew assignments, hotels, etc. But a Spartan never gives up. "We could not get a flight for four from Norfolk," Taylor said laughing. "After hours online and on the phone, we found a flight leaving from Maryland on New Year's Eve."

After another flight cancellation, a rental car mishap, and a lost backpack with the cash and identification, the travel warrior arrived in Pasadena at 2 a.m. on the day of the parade, January 2. "My kids and I missed all the scheduled events, but we did attend that parade and went to Disneyland," Taylor stated.

"I made a promise to my boys that I would take them to California. Were the trials and tribulations worth it? The answer was a resounding yes." In the parade stands with her entourage, Taylor remembered, "I felt such a sense of pride for Norfolk State University. I know firsthand about the sacrifice, time, energy, commitment, and dedication it takes to prepare for this kind of performance . . . the perseverance of the band staff and student musicians was embodied in their performance."

Taylor says it was essential she be there for her HBCU. "It was important to support Norfolk State as they



traveled across the United States and were spotlighted in one of the largest platforms the entire world tunes in to view. I wanted my two younger children to witness the band's performance. We made it and we were right where we were supposed to be – cheering on the Spartan Legion Marching Band."

There's a recurring theme among Norfolk State University alumni regarding financial support for the University . . . paying it forward. Archie Robinson, who resonates that same theme, graduated from NSU in 1970, and majored in industrial education and electronics. He has stayed connected to the University through his local Norfolk State University Alumni Association Chapter (NSUAA) in Herndon, Virginia.

A man of few words with a heart of gold, Robinson, as an active member of the NSUAA, enjoyed attending fundraising events sponsored by the D.C. chapter. "I participated in annual fundraisers for a while with this chapter. It gave me and others the opportunity to give back to the college." He continues to donate because it's a part of his soul. "It's what I got from Norfolk State that compels me to donate. My foundation and the ability to earn a good living are based on what I received from the college. So, I've got to pay it forward."

When asked what he would tell potential donors to encourage them to give to Norfolk State, Robinson said emphatically, "Norfolk State is a great place to attend college."

Legacy Of Philanthropy



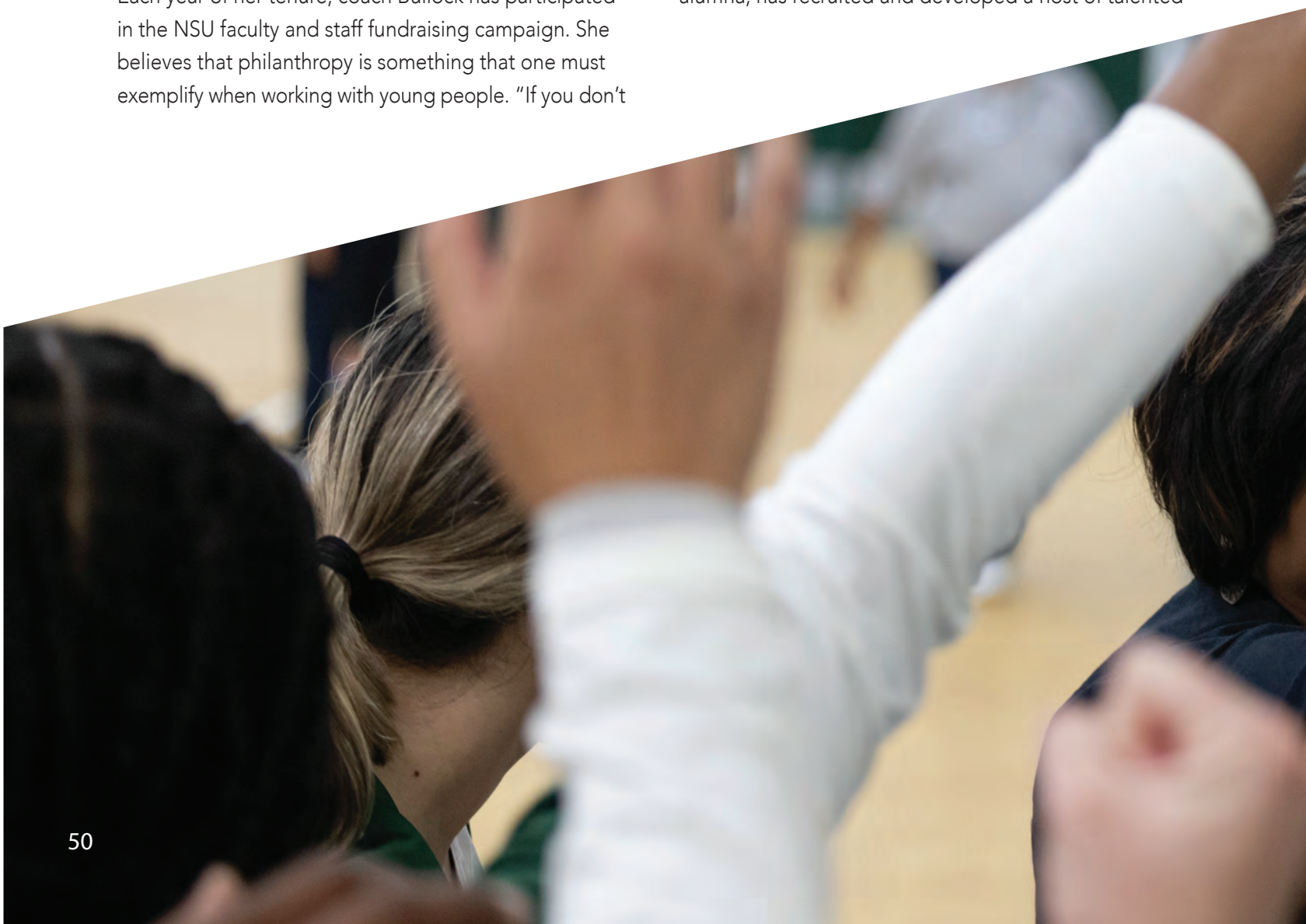
NSU Women's Volleyball Head Coach Kathy Bullock has been with the University for four short years, but she has already made an impact – one that has the potential to last for generations. While this is her fourth season leading the women's team, it is her

29th overall season as a head volleyball coach at the collegiate level. "Yes, volleyball is just as exciting," stated Bullock when asked about the game's competitiveness.

Each year of her tenure, coach Bullock has participated in the NSU faculty and staff fundraising campaign. She believes that philanthropy is something that one must exemplify when working with young people. "If you don't

set the example, you can't expect others to give." Bullock is already grooming her student-athletes to donate to causes they support. "I believe in giving back," she said referring to the annual Administrators, Faculty and Staff campaign. "It's the right thing to do." She believes that her student-athletes witness her generosity and reciprocate. "Right now, the students donate to the volleyball program." But the coach believes that her own giving is creating a legacy of giving in the next generations.

Coach Bullock leads, trains, and instructs a team of 18 to 20 players. Under her tutelage, Spartans earned eight victories in 2021, the most since the 2013 season. Since her arrival in Spartan country, the North Carolina A&T alumna, has recruited and developed a host of talented



and diverse students. "I encourage my players to give back to Norfolk State now, and because they are in the habit of giving, they will hopefully continue to do so after they graduate," Bullock affirmed.

The coach holds the distinction of being the all-time winningest coach while at Tennessee State with 177 wins. As a player at North Carolina A&T, she was a four-time all-MEAC first team selection, the first player in conference history to achieve the title. She was also an all-American in track in the 800 meters during the 1984-85 season.

Bullock's philosophy about contributing is simple . . . she wholeheartedly believes in giving back . . . but in her way

of thinking, and the example she has set, the volleyball coach has planted a fertile seed that will impact not only Norfolk State's current annual giving campaigns, but future alumni campaigns as well. Existing and former players, no matter their walk in life, will well remember the legacy seeded by Coach Kathy Bullock.
